



Special Education Paraprofessional (Para)

Special education paraprofessionals work under the overall supervision of the Special Education Coordinator and Executive Director with direct supervision provided by special education teachers.

Hourly \$14-\$16/hour

Benefits include health insurance, paid time off, and retirement.

Job Responsibilities:

Job responsibilities will vary depending upon the age of students served as well as the nature and severity of the student's disabilities:

- Assist in the educational and social development of students under the direction and guidance of the special education teacher and classroom teachers.
- Assist in the implementation of Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for the students and monitor their progress.
- Provide support for individual students inside and outside the classroom to enable them to fully participate in activities.
- Work with other professionals, such as speech therapist, school counselor, occupational and physical therapists.
- Work with special education teachers and classroom teachers to implement behavior plans for students with emotional or behavior concerns.

Requirements:

- Minimum would be to have at least a high school diploma with 1-2 years of college education classes very helpful
- 1-2 years experience working with children in special education
- Be capable of physically assisting students with special needs as required (positioning, lifting, transferring, restraining, etc.)
- Have demonstrated ability to work effectively under the direction of others

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- Have demonstrated ability to work cooperatively with others
- Have willingness to assume any responsibilities appropriate for the position
- Support the Mission Statement and Pedagogy of Mountain Song Community School
- Behave and speak in a professional manner at all times.
- Set a good example in terms of dress, punctuality, and attendance.
- Attend staff and team meetings.
- Be proactive in matters relating to health and safety.
- All other duties as assigned.

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
