Job Description Summary: The Reading Interventionist is responsible to provide curriculum leadership and strategies for teaching and supporting students in the literacy skills needed to learn to read, read to learn, and comprehend. Working within a classroom setting to help students who are lagging behind the rest of their class in their studies, this position is responsible for developing strategies to help their students become successful within the regular classroom.

Reports To: Executive Director

Job Status: Regular Part-time 0.5 FTE

Essential Duties:

1. The reading interventionist will run small group instruction for students in various grades
2. Will assist students in monitoring reading growth goals.
3. Will assess student learning, through observations, authentic performance, and more formal methods,
4. In an ongoing manner, provide frequent student feedback, information to parents and written progress reports.
5. In addition to the outlined job description, they will perform other duties as assigned.

7. Demonstrate professionalism in appearance, communication, manner, and punctuality.

Performance Standards:

Minimum Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required; Master's degree with extended educational focus in the area of reading preferred

- Strong instructional skills inclusive of oral and written communication
- Ability to interpret data and evaluate instruction programs and teaching effectiveness
- Ability to develop and deliver training to adult learners
- Strong organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills
- Three years' experience as a classroom teacher with specialization in reading preferred.

Physical Demands and Work Environment:
