- Supervision of a Health Aid and/or staff member in this role
- Manage, plan, and supervise the school screening program and make re-screen and referral decisions regarding the following mandated screening services:
 - Hearing
 - Vision
- Serve as member of the Individual Educational Plan (IEP) Team with preparation of Individual Health Care Plans (IHPs) for students with health needs within the school setting.
- Serve on the Safety Committee
